- Fencing \$64.15/week hire now.
- Working with children certificates required all current, need to get a copy. Dennis to follow up what is required for working with children certificate.
- End of progress report due end of May
- Dennis asking if committee feels the project will be complete by end of May and do we need an extension, committee decided we don't at this stage.
- Lynley received extra receipts and will do a final budget/reconciliation.
- 26K left currently.
- Dennis provided an estimation of costs for future needs.
- Dennis has completed a final report for this financial year's grant.
- Dennis to submit council grant application for next financial years donation 2K.
- Mark Duggan drafting person only sent an invoice for \$600 quote was for \$1200. Dennis
  to follow up with Mark Duggan re another invoice.
- Fencing company never sent an invoice just a quote.

#### **New Business:**

- Pat raised the idea of having a bookcase/box for gardening reference books that members can access and add too if required. Weather proof, not lockable, glass front, 3 selves. Pat to send Toni a picture of what looking for.
- Pat raised that a lady from council arrived to have a meeting in the hall and asked if the shed had council approval. Dennis to follow up with council.



- Pat raised having T-Shirts during construction and socials etc., for those working on the site. Logo on front, using Jimmy's logo, blue t-shirt with green logo. Current committee to receive one and members who are helping. Short sleeve, wide brim sun hats also. Toni to get quotes.

- Emails 70% open
- Facebook Group, Toni wants to change the Facebook group to a public page so we can share posts.
- Make video for vlogging and promotion.
- Website getting hits ang going well. Once Facebook page developed will share on Bendalong, Manyana website.
- Locks, temp fencing will be removed in a couple of weeks what type would we like –
  combination, keyed or what? Use current key lock until opening. Do we lock the garden
  or not committee discussed same nil consensus to go to members for vote, Toni to
  send out questions etc.
- Dennis asked the question if water feature needs to be approved by council, does it meet specifies, concerns about children accessing water. Pat replied no.
- Colour on shed do we match this with plant box. Committee decided on southerly colorbond colour.
- Signs Toni & Dennis to work with Gary regarding sign about garden to be placed above each gate, chalk board to be part of this.
- Opening Dennis has been thinking about bands and location of opening, suggested in the hall for post official opening events.
- Meeting frequency 2/12 next meeting April
- Toni suggested maybe we should have a mural on the roller door or water tank committee agreed to wait on this and re-think later once garden is established and evolves.
- Skateboard seat Pat to complete same, Dennis asked if he has an idea and needs a hand, Pat has concept.
