Attachment A - Grant criteria

To be competitive you must score highly against all of the assessment criteria.

Assessment criterion 1: How your project will assist in community recovery from the 2019–20 bushfires (50 points)

Assessment criterion 2: Capacity, capability and resources to deliver the project (50 points)

We will only consider funding applications that score at least 50% against each assessment criterion, as these represent best value for money.

When assessing if the application represents value with relevant money, we will regard the:

- overall objectives of the grant opportunity
- evidence provided to demonstrate how your project contributes to meeting those objectives
- relative value of the grant sought.
